National Bank of Anguilla (Private Banking and Trust) Ltd – Administrator Appointed ("PBT")

As you are aware from my letter of 3 June, on 26 May 2016, I filed a chapter 15 petition in the United States Bankruptcy Court in the Southern District of New York (the "US Bankruptcy Court") for recognition of (a) the proceeding in Anguilla as a 'foreign main proceeding' and (b) me as PBT's 'foreign representative'.

The application was heard and approved by the US Bankruptcy Court on 17 June 2016. In order to maximise the powers available to me in the United States, I determined it was also appropriate to file a chapter 11 petition in the US Bankruptcy Court. Chapter 11 will enable me to take steps that are not available under chapter 15 alone, including but not limited to more readily obtaining discovery against parties in the US pursuant to the US Bankruptcy Rules and the ability to challenge transactions during a period of up to 6 years before the filing date.

The petition was filed with the US Bankruptcy Court on 22 June 2016. A post filing hearing will take place on 24 June 2016. A copy of the notice in relation to the hearing is attached at Appendix 1.
